



Ride Terms & Conditions

Welcome to SuperJet Boating KOS Island! The only Turbo-Charged, Twin-Engine, 700Hp Jet-Boat ride in Europe!

SuperJet Boating is a thrilling fun-ride where you'll experience; High-Speed Fishtails, the awesome 180° SPIN&DIP, 360° Pivot & Reverse Thrust, Power-Brake Stops, full-speed Passes and even some Wave Jumping!

Whilst SuperJet-Boating is generally very safe, there are always some risks involved with Maritime and this type of activity. It is important you understand and are comfortable with the Terms & Conditions prior to booking your seat and/or boarding the SuperJet-Boat.

Please read the Terms & Conditions and let our friendly staff know if you have any concerns or questions.

- All passengers must be a minimum of 130cm tall and children under 14 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- Patrons who show signs of drug or alcohol intoxication will not be permitted to board the SuperJet-Boat.
- Management has the right to refuse any passenger from boarding the Jet-Boat at its absolute discretion or exclude anyone from participating in the SuperJet-Boat ride, despite whether or not a ticket has already been purchased.
- We take your safety very seriously. All passengers are required to take direction from the Skipper/Master as the need arises and follow his/her instructions accordingly.
- Whilst all due care is taken and the safety of our passengers is of paramount consideration; ultimately, all passengers riding on the SuperJet-Boat choose to do so at their own risk.
- It is a Licensing requirement by the local Port Authority that all passengers are expected to have basic swimming skills and feel competent in the water. Please do not take part in the Jet-Boat ride if you cannot swim.
- Any persons who suffer from chronic neck or back injuries, may be pregnant, have a heart condition, or similar injury, ailment or condition are advised against riding on the SuperJet-Boat.
- Passengers are advised not to carry valuables whilst riding the SuperJet-Boat. Management takes no responsibility for any loss or damage of valuables or personal property.
- Passengers must arrive, ready for boarding 15 minutes prior to departure time otherwise your place may be reassigned to other passengers and your ticket may be cancelled or rescheduled to another timeslot at Management's discretion.
- Management reserves the right to alter the ride schedule and may even cancel rides due to inclement weather, sea conditions or 'force majeure'. In the event of cancellation, rides will be rescheduled wherever possible or full refunds will be given where prior payment has been made.
- Any photography, film or video taken by SuperJet-Boating remains the property of SuperJet-Boating and can be used for marketing or other purposes at Management's discretion.
